NOTE TO PARENT/GUARDIAN AND STUDENT/GROUP MEMBER

In this agreement, the term “skiing” shall include “snowboarding,” “cross-country skiing,” and “snowshoeing,” and “we” shall refer to the participating student/group member and his/her parent(s) or guardian(s), or agent(s).

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

We are aware that skiing involves many risks, dangers and hazards and assume all the risks of personal injury or death or property loss resulting from any cause whatsoever, including but not limited to the inherent risks of skiing, and the use of ski lifts, collision with natural and man-made objects or other skiers, travel within or beyond the ski area boundaries, or negligence, breach of contract, or breach of statutory duty of care on the part of Ski Ben Eoin and its staff.

We agree that its employees and agents shall not be liable for any personal injury, death, or property loss and release Ski Ben Eoin and its employees and agents and waive all claims.

EQUIPMENT

Ski Ben Eoin provides rental equipment. We accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in the possession of my son/daughter/group member. We will be responsible for the replacement at full value of any equipment rented on the “Group Equipment User form” but not returned to the rental facility. We agree to return all rental equipment by the specified date.

We understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user’s safety.

- In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where the release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release.
- In snowboarding, cross-country skiing, and snowshoeing, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release due to forces generated during ordinary operation.
- We understand that a helmet designed for Recreational Snow Sports use will help reduce the risks of some types of injuries to the user at slower speeds.
- We recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high-energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.

We understand that helmets are required to be worn by students/group members while skiing.

- Helmets are not required for cross-country skiing.
- We further agree to defend and indemnify the PROVIDERS for any loss or damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death and property loss and damage related to the use of this equipment.

RESPONSIBILITY CODES - Ski Ben Eoin requires the parent/guardian and student/group member to know, understand and obey the ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE and CROSS-COUNTRY SKIER’S RESPONSIBILITY CODE. Teachers/group leaders, chaperones, Snow school Staff and Ski Patrol reserve the right to revoke a lift ticket in the event of a violation of the RESPONSIBILITY CODES or other unacceptable conduct. **Copies of Both Codes can be found on the “Programs” page at www.skibeneoin.com**

LIABILITY RELEASE

We agree to release Ski Ben Eoin, its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the manufacturers and distributors of the rental equipment (collectively the “PROVIDERS”), from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user’s participation in the sport of skiing, use of, or in any way related to the use of the rental equipment, including all liability which results from the negligence of the PROVIDERS or any other person or cause. The laws of Nova Scotia govern this agreement. If any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, it shall be severed, and the remaining provisions shall be given full force and effect.

Group Liability Release and Agreement

I understand and have explained to each member of the group that there are inherent and other risks in the sport of skiing. I understand and have explained to each group member that the sport of skiing and other recreational activities involve inherent risks of injury **and death**.

I understand and have explained to each member of the group the "Alpine and/or Cross Country Responsibility Code" approved by the Canadian Ski Patrol System and that adherence to these codes while participating in the sport of skiing could reduce the likelihood of injury to the members of the group, and to others.

I understand that using a helmet designed for "Recreational Snow Sports" will help reduce the risks of some types of injuries to the user at slower speeds. **I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high-energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn. I understand that helmets are required to be worn by all group members when skiing** (not required for Cross Country or snowshoeing).

This agreement is governed by the laws of Nova Scotia. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, it shall be severed and all of the remaining provisions shall be given full force and effect.
